Data collected from the portable multi-parameter YSI sonde at the Brixton Deverill high spec monitoring site for October:

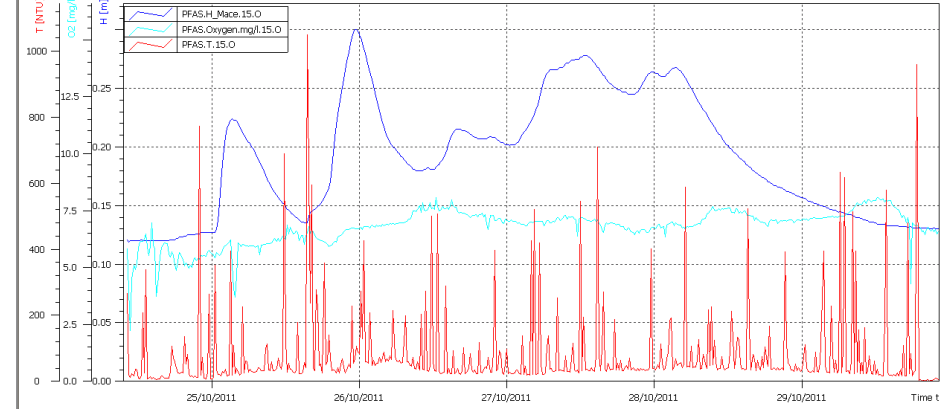


Please note that this data is collected in real time and is not quality assured.

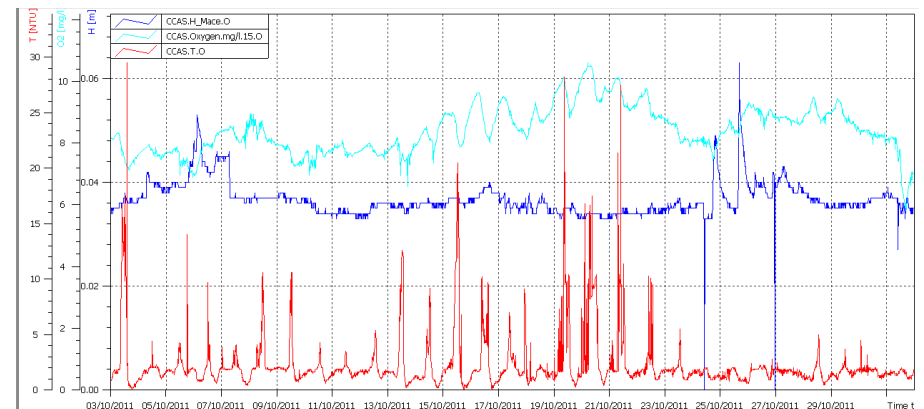
Priors Farm:
